I, the undersigned Official Veterinarian, hereby certify that the aquatic animals referred above:

Have been inspected within 72 hours of loading and showed no clinical signs of disease.

Are not subject to any prohibitions due to unresolved increased mortality.

Are not intended for destruction or slaughter for the eradication of diseases.

Originate from aquaculture farms which are under the supervision of the competent authority.

In case of molluscs, were subject to an individual visual check of each part of the consignment and no molluscs species other than those specified above were detected.

Are transported under conditions, including a water quality, that do not alter their health status.

The transport container is clean and disinfected or previously unused.

The consignment is identified by a legible label on the exterior of the container, or when transported by well boat, in the ship's manifest, with the relevant information referred to in this certificate, and the following statement:
