### HEALTH INFORMATION

I, the undersigned official Veterinarian, certify that the animal/s above described meets the following requirements:

1. Have been continuously resident in PORTUGAL for a minimum period of six months.
2. If a female cat, are not pregnant \*<sup>1</sup>.
3. Are in good health and free from clinical signs of contagious and infectious disease.
4. Were vaccinated against feline enteritis, feline rhinotracheitis and feline calicivirus at least fourteen (14) days and not more than twelve (12) months prior to export (the vaccination certificate/s, or copies endorsed by an Official Veterinarian, for these vaccinations are attached to this certificate).
5. Within fourteen (14) days prior to export were treated with approved anthelmintics effective against nematodes and cestodes.  
Active ingredient/s and dose rate:
6. Within 96 hours prior to export were treated with approved parasitocides effective against ticks.  
Active ingredient/s and concentration:
7. Within 48 hours prior to export were examined by a registered veterinarian or an Official Veterinarian and found to be free from clinical signs of infectious or contagious disease and external parasites, and to be fit to travel.

8. Were vaccinated against rabies with an inactivated vaccine (of at least one international antigenic unit) when at least three months of age and within two to twelve months prior to export (a copy of the Rabies vaccination certificate for the most recent vaccination is attached to this certificate).
- (a) (i) Are accompanied by a laboratory result form, from a laboratory approved by the Government Veterinary Authorities of Portugal, which indicates that the animal/s to be imported was subjected to a neutralizing antibody titration test for rabies in accordance with one of the methods described in the OIE Manual of Standards for diagnostic tests and vaccines, and found to have at least 0,5 IU/ml of antibody in its serum. The test was performed at least one month and not more than six months prior to export. The laboratory result forms clearly identify the animals to be imported, using the microchip transponder/ tattoo identification number of the animals;
- (ii) Are accompanied by a letter from the animal's veterinarian stating the date blood was taken from the animals for the laboratory testing detailed in 8 (a) (i) above.

This certificate is valid for 10 days from the date of issue.

\*<sup>1</sup> Kittens born in quarantine shall be destroyed without compensation.

NOTES:

It is required an import permit.

The cats must come on an IATA approved container.

Date and time of arrival and flight number should be communicated at least three days prior to arrival.

The cats will be quarantined for a minimum period of five working days at the Division of Veterinary Services, Reduit.
